



SUPPLIES:

VIEW THE STARS

Now it's time to actually see the stars! Here's some suggestions on how to make the most of your star-viewing experience:

- To get started, **TURN OFF ALL THE LIGHTS** in your area. House lights, outside lights, and more. The very best place to view stars would be about 30 minutes outside of a city, but your backyard can work!
- Try using a **STAR FINDING APP**. Some great choices are [SkyView Lite](#) or [Stellarium Plus](#).
- If you want to stay unplugged, try [printing out this image](#) of the **STARS YOU CAN SEE IN THE SKY** during this time of year.

READ A BOOK:
