### PUMPKIN WHITE CHOCOLATE CHIP COOKIES

#### INGREDIENTS:

- 1/2 cup butter
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 1 cup pumpkin puree
- 1 egg
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 2 1/4 cups flour
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 1/4 tsp pumpkin pie spice
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1 1/2 cups white chocolate chips

#### DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Cream butter and both sugars.
- 2. Add pumpkin puree, egg, and vanilla.
- 3. Slowly add all dry ingredients. Batter will be gooey!
- 4. Fold in white chocolate chips.
- Drop a heaping spoonful two inches apart on a sheet pan with parchment paper.
- 6. Bake at 375 degrees for 13 minutes. The cookies will still be slightly soft and pillowy.

## GET COOKING!

### QUINOA SALAD WITH ROASTED BEETS & CARROTS

#### INGREDIENTS:

- 1/4 red onion, diced
- 2 tsp Dijon mustard
- 1/3 cup red wine vinegar
- 1/4 cup olive oil
- 3 beets, peeled, chopped to small chunks
- 3 carrots, peeled, chopped to small chunks
- 1 tsp red wine vinegar
- 2 tsp olive oil
- Salt & pepper, to taste
- 1 cup quinoa, uncooked
- 2 cups vegetable broth
- 3 cups kale, chopped
- 1/4 cups herbs (like parsley, basil, thyme)

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees.
- 2. Make the dressing: Mix the first four ingredients (red onion, mustard, vinegar, and oil) really well until fully incorporated.
- 3. In a medium bowl, mix the beets and carrots with red wine vinegar and olive oil. Season with salt and pepper. Place veggies on a sheet pan and cook in preheated oven for at least 30 minutes or until nicely roasted.
- 4. Quinoa: Bring the vegetable broth and quinoa to a boil. Once boiling, cover, turn heat down, and simmer for 20 minutes.
- 5. Once everything is prepared, mix it all together with kale and herbs. Enjoy hot or cold!


