**Fine Arts - Knitting:** Come learn how to hand-weave with our loops and looms project.

**Fit & Kick:** (1st & 2nd grades only) *New to Junior Camp!* A "get moving" type class where you'll learn some self-defense and kickboxing.

**Gymnastics:** Enjoy learning the basic techniques and developing your skills.

**Landsports (includes Basketball, Kickball, Soccer, Softball, etc.):** All of our Landsports classes spend time going over basic skills and fundamentals and then putting those into practice through fun games and play with your cabin group.

**Landsports - Volleyball:** *New to Junior Camp!* Practice the basic skills of setting, spiking, passing, digging, and serving.

**Pickleball:** *New to Junior Camp!* Hit the courts with your friends during class, during free time, or after dinner - really there is not enough time in the day for all the Pickleball fun! It is

What better way to beat the sun than some lake fun at the Greystone water park - from sliding down our junior 100-foot waterslide and our giant 170-foot super slide, paddling, blobbing, and jumping on our 30-foot water trampoline...there is something for everyone at this class!
