### DR. SEVIER AND "LADY"

Twenty-five years have passed since Dr. Sevier first opened the gates of Camp Greystone to eager and ambitious American girls. Under his and Mrs. Sevier's ever-present guidance, Greystone has continued to grow into one of the outstanding camps of the country.

Dr. Sevier feels that a camp is never finished. Thus each summer Greystone girls find improvements in a place which they had thought to be perfect. By his interest in and understanding of each camper, each girl is able to find even more happiness. His own thoughtful actions, his cheerful disposition, his words of counsel, his participation and interest in every camp event have made him an inspiration to all. This summer marks the twenty-fifth time that over a hundred girls have looked up to their friend and said, "Thank you, Dr. Sevier."

## History of Greystone



Away up in the Smoky Mountains of East Tennessee lies a beautiful spot, overlooking the long, green valleys; peaceful above the clouds and passing storms of the lower hills... "Greystone Mountain"... the perfect setting for a camp. So thought Dr. and Mrs. Sevier, twenty-five years ago, when the girls of the Southland first begged to be given the privilege of a whole summer of camping, such as their brothers had enjoyed for years!

Some folks thought the idea was crazy—said—"GIRLS can't camp! They are afraid of BUGS! Why they can't even swim!"

However, over 100 girls disproved this idea and arrived in 1920, with a huge assortment of voluminous bloomers, long black stockings, and "cover-all" bathings suits with frisky puffed caps (which never could have survived one modern dive!)

Greystone was a huge success, and loved by its many campers. But it needed one thing to make it perfect—a large lake. So the perfect setting was found on beautiful Lake Summit in North Carolina. In 1922 the Greystone girls arrived at Tuxedo with their usual enthusiasm—but minus the baggy bloomers. Some daring ones (let this be whispered) even wore BOYS KNICKERS—KNEE LENGTH! Girls began to dive, and when they didn't have to pull twenty yards of bathing suit along—really became good swimmers.

Dancing in floating veils was the fad—and the pageant court was the scene of many a lovely play. Then came the jazz era, with tap dancing and speed-boats cutting the blue waters of Lake Summit.

The surrounding mountains kept watch over Greystone, growing and becoming more beautiful through the years. New buildings, new improvements, always finer and better equipment was added, but the same high ideals and fine leadership of Dr. and Mrs. Sevier prevailed.

Miss Janie McGaughey was first Head Councillor; Miss MaNita Bullock was the second; and Miss Jean Agnew the third and present head of Greystone's fine Councillor group.

Girls of Greystone 1944, drawn from twenty states, are brown as berries, up-to-the-minute in their shorts and two-piece bathing suits. But the Spirit of Greystone, which made the girls of 1920 outstanding, burns even brighter through the years. Greystone welcomes its "granddaughters" now, girls whose mothers remember their own happy days at camp.

May Greystone's next twenty-five years be as happy and full of glorious days for the finest type of American girl—THE GREYSTONE GIRL!
