

Through fifty years Greystone has been a leader among camps. The high ideals and fine example of its founders have made the girls strive ever toward higher goals of good sportsmanship.



HISTORY OF GREYSTONE

Away up in the Smoky Mountains of East Tennessee lies a beautiful spot, overlooking the long, green valley; peaceful above the clouds and passing storms of the lower hills . . . "Greystone Mountain" . . . the perfect setting for a camp. So thought Dr. and Mrs. Sevier, twenty-five years ago, when the girls of the Southland first begged to be given the privilege of a whole summer of camping, such as their brothers had enjoyed for years!

Some folks thought the idea was crazy—said—"GIRLS can't camp! They are afraid of BUGS! Why they can't even swim!"

However, over 100 girls disproved this idea and arrived in 1920, with a huge assortment of voluminous bloomers, long black stockings,

and "cover-all" bathing suits with frisky puffed caps (which never could have survived one modern dive!)

Greystone was a huge success, and loved by many campers. But it needed one thing to make it perfect—a large lake. So the perfect setting was found on beautiful Lake Summit in North Carolina. In 1922 the Greystone girls arrived at Tuxedo with their usual enthusiasm—but minus the baggy bloomers. Some daring ones (let this be whispered) even BOYS KNICKERS—knee LENGTH! Girls began to dive, and when they didn't have to pull twenty yards of bathing suit along—really became good swimmers.

Dancing in floating veils was the fad—and the pageant court was the scene of many a lovely play. Then came the jazz era, with tap dancing and speed-boats cutting the blue waters of Lake Summit.

The surrounding mountains kept watch over Greystone, growing and becoming more beautiful through the years. New buildings, new improvements, always finer and better equipment was added, but the same high ideals and fine leadership prevailed. Dr. and Mrs. Sevier's deaths in the winter of 1944-45 were a great loss to Greystone, but their training of a fine counselor staff helped Virginia Sevier Hanna, their daughter, to carry on the traditions and ideals on which Greystone had been founded.

The head conselors throughout the years have been superlative in their leadership. Miss Janie McGaughey was the first Head Counselor, Miss Manita Bulock was the second, and Miss Jean Agnew was the third. Miss Agnew continued in this position until she joined Mrs. Hanna as director in the 50's. Jean Murphy (Mrs. Wilson) Williams, Rachel Paxon (Mrs. John) Hayes, and Jan Wells were head counselors over the next 10 years, and the present fine leader is Dot Frances (Mrs. Richard) Newcomer. Each were counselors at Greystone for years before becoming Head Counselor.

In 1967, the third generation of the Sevier family joined the directorship as Libby Hanna Miller and her husband Jim became full directors. Libby, like her mother, grew up at Greystone and loved every part of her camp heritage. Jim has been a fine addition and Libby and Jim live at Greystone the year 'round.

The second twenty-five years of camp have sped by all too quickly, with hundreds of campers sharing the spirit and enthusiasm which has always been present at Greystone. Though the hair styles change and the clothes are cut in the latest style each year, the girls are still the finest in the land and carry the spirit of Greystone ever higher.

Girls of 1969 are drawn from 27 states and several foreign countries, and Greystone's campers have spread all over the world. Each year daughters of Greystone girls return to camp and carry on the traditions with all the enthusiasm that their mothers showed. We call these our "Greystone Granddaughters" and over 75 are in camp this Golden Anniversary year. It has indeed been a golden year of great experiences for all of us!

May Greystone's next fifty years be as happy and full of glorious days for the finest type of American girl — The GREYSTONE GIRL.
