Lawton: "Do you ride at home?"

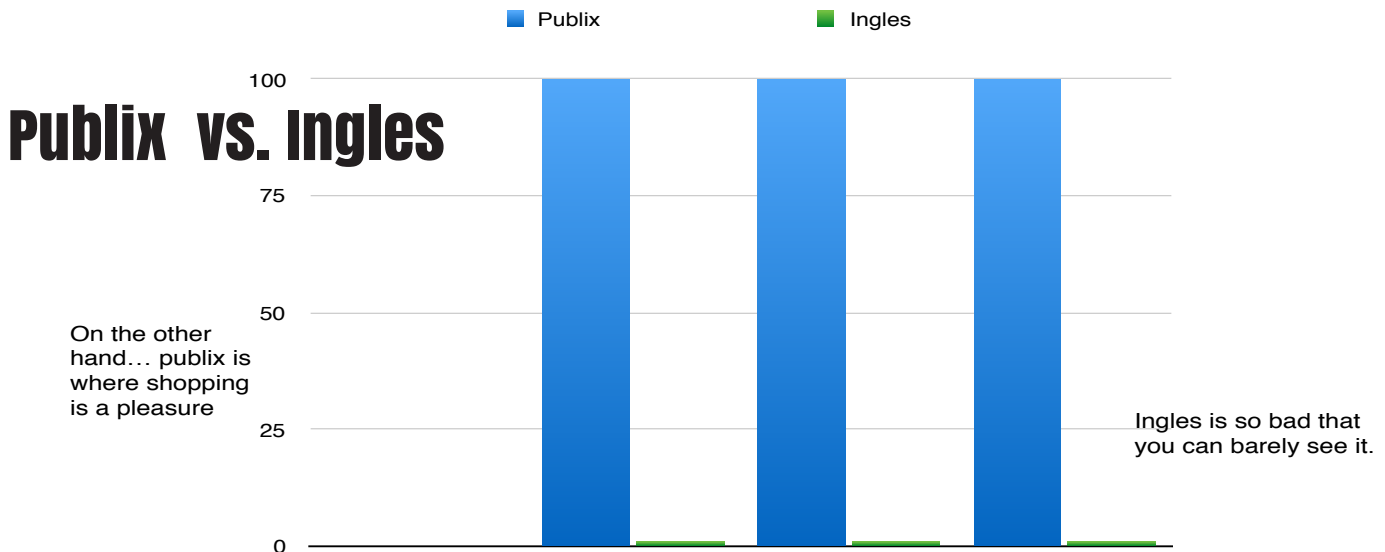
Emmy: "I love ridding in Wyoming. I just got lessons."

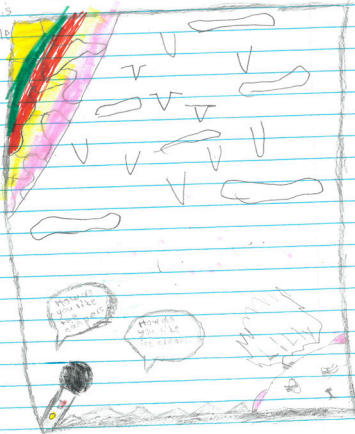

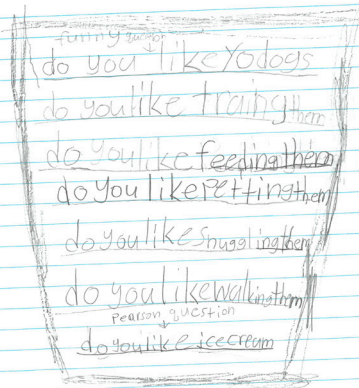
