





Campers used to have to pay for their Candy Shoppe. Girls would get a \$10 SHOPPE CARD and when you selected your item, the counselor at the window would mark off that amount on the card. Everyone had to be careful not to lose their card; it was like cash!

FOR WATERSPORTS DAY, THE ENTIRE CAMP WALKED TO THE SWIM DOCKS TO WATCH THE RACES AND SYNCHRONIZED SWIMMING. THESE SWIM DOCKS WERE ON LAKE SUMMIT AND WERE OVER A MILE FROM THE FRONT GATE!
