MEDICATION PACKAGING INSTRUCTIONS

FOR FAMILIES TO SHARE WITH LOCAL PHARMACISTS

TO COMPLY WITH NC STATE GUIDELINES AND AMERICAN CAMP ASSOCIATION SAFETY STANDARDS, WE REQUIRE THAT ALL DAILY MEDICATIONS BE FILLED BY A PHARMACIST IN A BLISTER PACKAGE SIMILAR TO THE PICTURE HERE.



PLEASE FOLLOW THESE STEPS:

1. Please provide a separate blister pack for each time of day that the medication is dispensed (breakfast, lunch, dinner, bedtime).

For example, if a medication is taken at breakfast and dinner, we need 2 separate blister packs: 1 for breakfast & 1 for dinner.

2. Multiple medications taken at the same time of day may be packaged together or separately, but any medication taken at a different time of day must be in a separate blister pack.

3. The typed pharmacy label must be an official label from the pharmacy (like an Rx bottle label) and affixed to the blister pack.

- **The label must include:** camper name, physician name, medication name, dose, strength, and instructions for administration. We cannot accept handwritten labels that do not include the pharmacist's name.

4. If the daily medication is a spray, inhaler, a powder (like Miralax), or a manufacturer blistered chewable and cannot fit in the bubble on the package, please affix the official pharmacy label (described in #3) to the blister pack and attach the medication in a BAG on the back of the blister package.

- Our nurses use the blister pack as our system of administering medication even if the medication isn't in the actual bubbles.

5. If a prescription needs to be filled for camp before the next refill is available through insurance, please try a "vacation override" to satisfy the insurance company.
