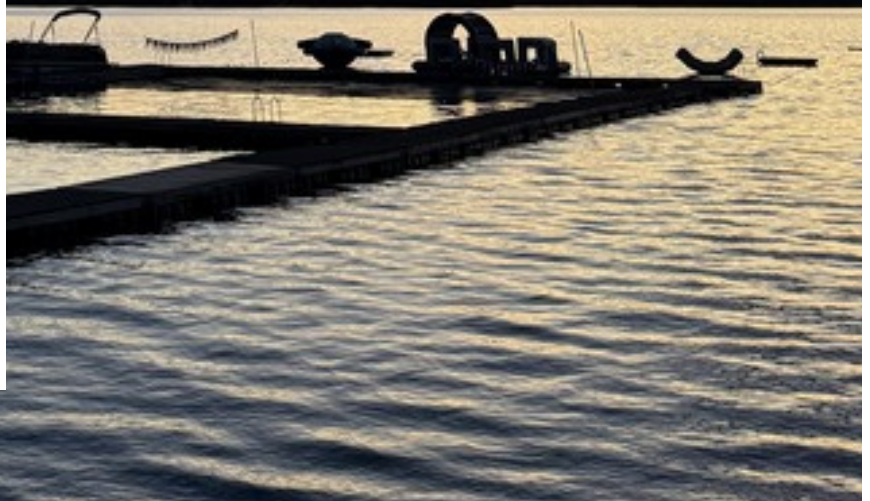

A MESSAGE FROM JOLLY & CORI

Five summers ago, we stood at the beginning of a journey that felt equal parts exciting, humbling, and uncertain. We believed that girls deserved a place where they could discover their strengths and grow into leaders with confidence, kindness, and courage. We believed deeply in what Robindel could be.

This summer marks our fifth season as directors. In Robindel tradition, five summers earns you a Silver CR - a small token that represents commitment and belonging. It is given not simply because of the passage of time, but because someone has invested themselves in this community year after year.

As we reflected on this milestone, we realized that this Silver CR doesn't just belong to us, but also to everybody who believed in our vision and helped carry it forward.

Camp families have entrusted us with their daughters and partnered with us in believing that camp is about far more than activities. They understand that the camp experience can shape character, build confidence, foster resilience, and create friendships that last a lifetime.

Our extraordinary staff have set aside their own summers to pour themselves into the lives of children. They teach skills, yes, but more importantly, they model empathy, respect, teamwork, honesty, and friendship every single day. They remind us that leadership is found in countless quiet moments: a conversation in the gazebo, encouragement after a difficult lesson, laughter shared over a meal, or choosing patience when that is the harder option.

We owe thanks to the camp consultants who have taken the time to truly understand who we are. Rather than simply helping families find a camp, they have connected us with families who share our belief that character matters, relationships matter, and childhood matters.

It is well known that the Robindel alumni community is one of a kind. Your stories remind us that Robindel has always been about something much bigger than a single summer. Your love for Robindel continues to inspire us as we work to honor traditions while thoughtfully preparing for the generations still to come.

Thank you for helping us build a community where girls know they matter, where childhood is treasured, and where leadership begins with caring for one another.
