MEDICATION

- All meds (Rx and OTC) must be in original packaging, including inhalers & EpiPens, with clear dosing instructions on packaging.
- Put all meds in Ziploc bag labeled with full name and hand to car greeter on Opening Day. Do not put any meds in trunks. NO meds may be in cabins.
- Enter all meds (Rx & OTC) in health form prior to camp.
- NO vitamins or supplements unless documented deficiency by physician and listed in health form.
- Meds returned in trunk at end of camp.

LICE

- The best way to start camp is to get checked for lice within 7 days before drop off.
- We have partnered with Lice Clinics of America to streamline our Opening Day lice checks. We will conduct a lice check when campers arrive, but those who have been checked with LCA the week before will skip the check and start camp faster.

MAIL

- There are three types of mail at camp: traditional mail, email, and pre-written letters that may be dropped off on Opening Day.
- Snail mail is slow- allow 3 days for snail mail to arrive & discontinue sending mail at least 4 days before your camper's term ends.
- Purchase electronic stamps on CampInTouch for emails (printed at 10:45 a.m. each day).
- Label all prewritten letters with camper's full name in a large Ziploc bag and hand to car greeter on Opening Day.
- NO packages at camp. One birthday package is allowed.

FORMS

All forms are due May 1st

Forms will be available from **February 1st** in your CampInTouch account or in the Campanion Mobile App.

CAMPANION

- Log into the Campanion Mobile App with your camp username and password for summer updates and to download and share camper photos.
 Please be sure to upload a current photo of your camper prior to the beginning of their term.
- There is a small fee for Campanion. To opt out of this service, please email info@campchampions.com.

CABINMATE REQUESTS

- Campers must each request each other
- Campers must attend same number of weeks
- Campers must be in the same grade
- Requests should completed no later than two weeks before camp starts

- Brimmed Cap (2) (Little League campers are given special hats)
- Pajamas/Sleepwear (2)
- T-shirt and pair of shorts that can get TRASHED!
- Special outfit for T-Bone Club (Those who just completed eighth gradesundress, polo shirt, nice shorts, etc.)
- Special outfit for first year Senior Campers

For campers in attendance for two or more weeks, laundry will be washed, dried, and folded.
