

## CIT Applicant Parent Agreement 2021

The CIT selection process is one of the most difficult parts of camp as each applicant is a beloved member of our camp family. We realize this will be a difficult and emotional process for everyone involved, so we respectfully ask that parents consider all outcomes of this process before allowing your child to apply for the program.

Each year, we have more qualified candidates apply for the CIT program than our capacity will allow. As a result, not every candidate is accepted into the program. We strongly considered cancelling the program in an effort to spare feelings and reduce the emotional stress on us as camp owners. However, we recognize the valuable life skills and individual growth that this program offers, as well as the character building lessons for those candidates who are not selected.

In order for your child to apply, you must agree to the following guidelines. Please have both parents initial each line and sign and date the bottom of the agreement stating you understand and agree to comply with these expectations.
