CLOTHING

- 1 Pair of Sport Sandals with a back strap (Teva, Chaco, etc.)

TOILETRIES

- Deodorant
- Shampoo & Conditioner
- Body Wash or Bar Soap with carry case
- Toothpaste & Toothbrush (with case)
- Hairbrush/Comb
- Disposable Razor & Shaving Cream (if applicable)
- Shower Caddy
- Medication (if applicable, will be stored in Health Hut)

BEDDING

- 1 Blanket
- 1 Pillow and 2 Pillow Cases
- 1 Set of Twin Sheets
- 1 Mattress Foam or Egg Crate (optional)

ACCESSORIES

- 1 Rain Poncho/Jacket (Water Proof)
- 1 Flashlight with Batteries
- Crazy Creek Chair (can purchase at Camp Store)
- 1 Sleeping Bag
- Backpack (soft)
- Water Bottle
- Sunscreen
- Bug Spray

PACKING TIPS

- Pack old clothing! Clothes can get lost & sometimes ruined.
- Label EVERYTHING with permanent marker or nametag.
- If shipping Fedex please **box all luggage!**



Minimum of 10 cloth face coverings

1. All face coverings should be labeled with the campers first and last name or first initial and last name.
- Two or three layers of permeable fabric
2. Masks that fit properly
3. Masks made with tightly woven fabric
4. Face Shields and neck gators are not an approved face covering.

All campers must wear a face mask if also wearing a face shield.
