

GRANDPARENT VISITING DAY

Sunday, August 2nd



We recognize the importance of allowing grandparents to visit their granddaughters during the summer. We believe this is something the girls look forward to and enjoy a great deal. In order to allow grandparent visits while maintaining the flow of the program for the campers, we have chosen to dedicate only one day for these visits; Sunday, August 2nd.

General Information

- We are <u>unable</u> to provide golf carts or mobility assistance devices on this day.
- We will be able to ensure all campers are in camp for this day.
- Grandparents only (we cannot accommodate Parents/Aunts/Uncles, Cousins, Friends, etc.)
- We are **not** able to accommodate grandparents on any other day.
- Visiting hours are 10:30am 2:30pm.
- All visits must be scheduled prior to arrival.

Upon Arrival

- Kindly park in the designated areas, staff members will assist with this. Please keep in mind, due to the unique nature of this day, handicap parking is not readily available.
- All Grandparents must sign in with the office staff.
- Nametags must be displayed at all times.

During the visit

- Campers must attend all activities.
- Grandparents will be our guests for *lunch Please observe posted mealtimes. (*Gluten-Free/Vegetarian/Vegan options are available-kindly inform us in advance via email)
- Staff members will be available for help should assistance be required.
- Smoking is not permitted on the campus.

Important Information

***NO OUTSIDE FOOD, SNACKS OR DRINKS OF ANY KIND may be brought into camp on this day. If you have dietary considerations for lunch, please inform us in advance.

- Campers are not permitted to leave camp for any reason.
- Bunk/Group gifts or supplies of any kind are **never** allowed.
- No tipping or gratuities permitted by Grandparents
- In accordance with our policy, cellular devices are not allowed to be used on the camp property.

To ensure fairness and equal treatment for all campers in our community, the Directors are unable to honor requests for exceptions or special treatment under this policy

*** In recent years we have witnessed behavior where the focus was less and less on the actual visit of the grandparents, and more on the food items that grandparents were bringing for their grandchildren. With the recent proliferation of food allergies, our concern about outside food and snacks has become a much larger issue - and we have found ourselves with the increasingly difficult task of providing a food-safe campus for all campers and staff.
