

REUNION FAQs

What is the difference between full and partial registration?

The only difference is lodging. With full registration, you can expect to stay on camp property (in a cabin, camping, or an RV) for the whole weekend. Partial registration is for those booking lodging on their own in Durango.

Ah, bummer - I can't make this reunion! When will the next one be?

Reunions happen every five years at CSC and are open to current or former campers and staff of CSC and their families. They typically follow the camp season in August. The next one is scheduled to be in 2025 (we are a few years late with this one due to the pandemic!)

If I am flying into Durango, is airport transportation provided?

Yes! We can coordinate airport pickups. No need to rent a car.

Can I stay in my favorite cabin?

Yes! During registration you will be able to make cabin requests for you and your group. All camp areas will be open.

I have specific dietary restrictions. Can you accommodate them?

Yes! Much like our campers during the summer, we can accommodate all dietary needs. We will collect this information closer to the reunion weekend.

Are dogs allowed?

Sorry - no extra animals allowed at camp.

What is the weather like?

You can expect highs in the 80s during the day, and lows in the 50s. The weather can dip at night in the valley, layers are the name of the game!

Anything specific I should pack?

- Sturdy, comfortable shoes for walking around camp
- Hiking boots if you plan on a larger hike for the All Day
- Water shoes if you plan on hanging at the lake
- A fun costume for dress up dinner (though the costume closet will be open!) You can also donate any costume to the closet after the reunion
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen
- A hat
- Layers!
- Rain gear
- Sleeping Bag
- Towel
- Toiletries

What are the sleeping situations like at camp these days?

The cabins will be cleaned following the summer and ready for the reunion. All cabins have twin sized bunk beds with mattresses. Bring your own bedding, either twin sized sheets or a sleeping bag.

Can I bring an RV?

Yes, but there will not be any RV hookups available. Let us know if you plan on bringing an RV and we can direct the best parking spot for the weekend.

If I want to camp instead, is that allowed? Will there be bathroom access?

Yes! Camping is allowed in camp. We will share which bathhouse to use for those wanting to camp.

Can I stay longer if I want to explore Durango more?

Yes! If you plan on staying in Durango longer than the weekend and wish to stay at camp, contact the office directly to talk about options. Additional fees may apply.
