- Your well-being is very important to us. You are required to review our health and safety recommendations before arriving at Green River Preserve. They are listed below.
- Please adhere to the <u>Leave No Trace Principles</u>
- No more than 10 people at a campsite. If you have more people, you will need to rent an additional campsite.
- Expect that you will not have cellular service while on the property. Sometimes, you will find service along the Upper Bald field and on Long Rock but do not count on it.
- Green River Road and Pinnacle Mountain Road are public roads. Please display your parking pass on the dash of your vehicle for the duration of your stay. Failure to do so may result in the reporting of your vehicle as trespassing.
- Please do not come to basecamp while you are visiting. We know this is hard, but we have ongoing projects at this time and want to keep those working and living on property safe and as isolated as they choose to be.
- No smoking, no vaping, and no illegal substances.
- Please keep your dog on a leash at all times if they are camping with you. We want to
 protect the wildlife and your beloved pet while on the property.
- If you choose to go into Dupont, please follow their <u>rules and regulations</u>.
- If you are camping at Hemlock Field and Prayer Rock, be aware that the GRP property line is at the eastern end of the Hemlock Field (the opposite end of the Hemlock campsite). Please do not trespass on the neighboring property.
- Enjoy the trails! Please be aware that others may be camping so respect your distance and practice <u>social distancing guidelines</u>.
- Please call 911 if you experience an emergency. We have two local fire stations as well:
 Cedar Mountain Fire and Rescue and Green River Fire and Rescue.
- Remember, it always rains on campout, so make sure you have appropriate gear and clothing.
- Make sure to do a sweep of your campsite at the end of you stay. Leave it as clean, if not cleaner, than when you arrive.
- If you want to fish while camping at Hemlock Field or Prayer rock it is an extra \$35 per person for the day. Please purchase a <u>fishing license</u> in order to fish and let Catherine know. Fly fishing only, all catch and release and please use only barbless hooks.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION DURING COVID-19

- We have taken reasonable additional measures in an effort to reduce exposure to COVID-19 for all of the Green River Preserve Community.
- COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death.
 An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any place where people are present.
