

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS (LISTED ON OUR CAMPER APPLICATION)

- Listens to and comprehends oral communication.
- Effectively communicates and comprehends both verbal and written communications.
- Comfortable in an outdoor or natural setting.
- Can hike up to three miles each day.
- Exhibits self-control and self-regulation.
- Recognizes and responds positively to social cues of peers and adults.
- Recovers from setbacks and challenges in a developmentally appropriate way.
- Can function and thrive in a community with little personal space.
- Respects and obeys authority.
- Maintains personal hygiene without assistance of others.

TERMS FOR ENROLLMENT

- 1. Payment schedule includes the following
 - 2 weeks upon acceptance of enrollment, secure enrollment with deposit.
 - \$500 for sessions 1 & 5
 - \$1000 for sessions 2, 3, 4, & 6
 - February 1st, pay 50% of total tuition.
 - April 1st, tuition balance is due.
- 2. A 3% per month carrying charge will be applied to past due balances of tuition and fees.
- 3. In the event of withdrawal, tuition is refundable, minus a \$500 cancellation fee, if written notice is received by the camp office by **February 1st**. For cancellations after

- February 1st, tuition is non-refundable. As of June 1st, any past due accounts will result in cancellation of camper's enrollment and no refund of any tuition.
- 4. **Green River Preserve** reserves the right to dismiss, without refund, any camper whose behavior is inappropriate in a camp community. If a participant withdraws voluntarily or is sent home as a consequence of unacceptable behavior, no refund will be granted. No refund or prorated tuition is made for late arrival or early departure.
- 5. **Green River Preserve** reserves the right to use photographs of our campers for promotional purposes in written material and on social media.
- 6. Medical attention from <u>camp medical staff</u> is included in tuition. This does not include the cost of prescription medicines, special doctor services, or hospital care.
- 7. **Green River Preserve** operates under a strict No Lice/Nits Policy. Our medical staff will screen and treat any campers (treatment cost is \$250/camper) who arrive at camp with lice or nits, or the parent reserves the right to take the camper home. Campers may not return until they are fully lice/nit free.
- 8. Camp operates with the highest safety standards. However it does not assume liability for sickness, disease, or accidents.
- 9. **Green River Preserve's** medical staff may share relevant medical information to Camp administrative staff, if the health issue pertains to the safety and well-being of the greater camp community, in order to put appropriate safeguards in place.
- 10. I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the camp director to order X-Rays, routine tests, and administer of over-the-counter medication and treatment for the health of my child and in the event I cannot be reached in an emergency, I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the camp director to hospitalize, secure proper treatment for, and to order injection and/or anesthesia and/or surgery for my child as named above.
- 11. I understand that Green River Preserve will never provide my contact or personal information to any outside, third-party vendors not associated with GRP.
- 12. I hereby give permission for my camper to participate in a full range of overnight summer camp activities with other campers and staff. I understand some of these activities will be conducted off the camp premises and/or may involve people, companies and/or entities who are not employed by the Summer Camp. I also understand that my child will be transported by motor-vehicle on and off the Summer Camp premises. I am familiar with the activities offered by the Summer Camp and have had a full opportunity to ask about these activities and any associated risks.
