Dear Skyline Parents and Campers,

Your daughter is approaching her last summer as a camper - her Age Out year! She is now eligible to participate in our Leadership Training (LT) Program, which provides our oldest campers an opportunity to experience a new role at Skyline, if they desire to do so.

The Leadership Training Program is just that - a program to develop leadership skills. We tailor the experience to prepare campers for all areas of their lives whether at school, church, extra-curricular activities, peer groups, and jobs.

What does it look like to take part in the Leadership Training Program?

- Participate in LT class activity period. Includes team building activities, group discussions, activity observation, activity facilitation, and Bible study.
- Assist in specific camp activities.
- **Arrive at camp one day early** for LT Orientation and to help with camp's Opening Day procedures.
- ★ Campers **CAN** be a part of the LT Program and participate as an ACIT in the same session.

What does it take to be in the Leadership Training Program?

- Must be at least a **rising junior** in high school.
- Must be a responsible member of the camp community (positive, on time, actively engaged in activities, dressed appropriately, and respectful to fellow campers and all staff members.)
- Must have a desire to serve others and put the needs of others ahead of your own.
- Must have a desire to form positive relationships with others at camp that are not in your core group of friends.
- Must fill out the LT Registration form.

How do you sign up for the Leadership Training Program?

- Have a current camper application on file for Summer 2021.
- Have the LT Registration form sent in by **May 1, 2021** (mail, email, fax).
We will email you upon receipt of LT Registration form. If you have not heard from us within 2 weeks of submission, please let us know.
- If coming for more than one session, please indicate on LT Registration form which session(s) you want to participate.

Please note that being a LT camper does not guarantee, and is not necessary for, future employment at Camp Skyline.

Due to Covid the LT Program will look different than previous summers, we still plan on facilitating the class in a way that best serves our LT campers and our Covid protocols. We will let you know more about what the program will entail come May.
