


All about Deerkill Day Camp

Deerkill Day Camp is built on 15 wooded acres and is a 3rd generation family-run business. Started in 1958, it's a

tight-knit community of campers from ages 3 to 14. Children that attend typically want to stay, and they're known for their low turnover among campers as well as counselors. Camp days usually begin around 9am, and are split into

arts & crafts, ceramics, woodworking, nature, ropes, dance, theater, digital photography, tennis, and graphic arts among others. The swim program is what Deerkill believes is their best offering, as they say even the youngest of campers are jumping off the diving board by the end of the summer. but the campers' challenges come mostly from within, and





participation. Costs for the camp are dependent on the age of the camper, and how long they'll attend. Sessions range from 4-8 weeks, and cost anywhere between \$2,000 and \$4,500. Shorter programs are also available for campers 3 and 4 years of

age. Costs include all field trips (including the Bronx Zoo, Van Saun Park and many others,) transportation, hot lunches,
